Place de l'Eperon

From the 13th century, and under English domination, the city was equipped with ramparts: its high thick walls and its geographical position earned it the "title" of "first goddaughter of Bordeaux". For centuries, it suffered the assaults of soldiers who coveted Bordeaux, the capital.

Place du District

The name of this square recalls that Bourg was the capital of the district of Blaye for a few years after the Revolution.

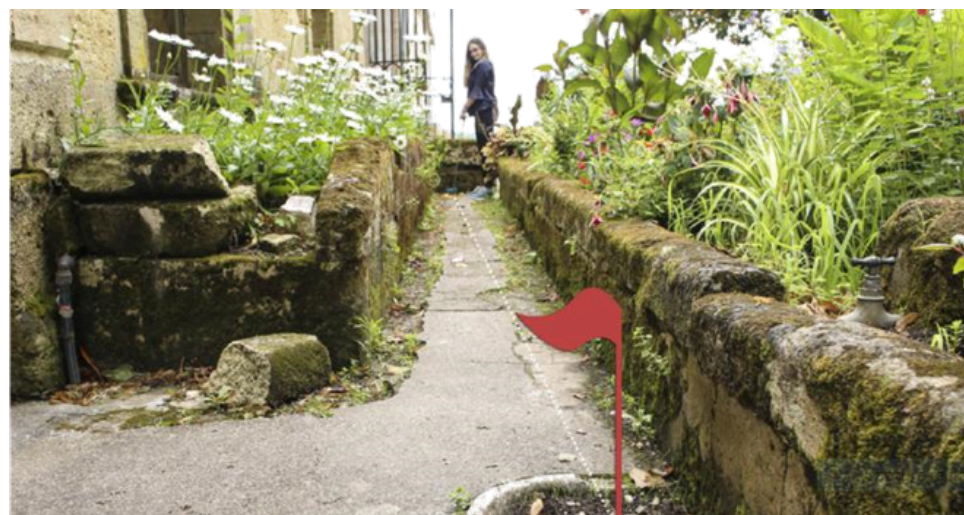
Citadelle de Bourg

After the church, enter the citadel park, citadel square.

Which museum is located within the citadel ?

Proceed along the gravel path. On the right, go through the second gate and immediately turn right. Set up as shown below and play !



Walk up to the ramparts and admire the view over the Dordogne.

Did you know ?



The location of this place, which is called "Château de la Citadelle", has successively known: a Gallo-Roman residence, a fortified castle built by the King of England in the 13th century and a citadel built by the Duke of Epernon at the end of the 16th century.

Louis XIV ordered its destruction in 1663. The Bourquais call the building that succeeded it a "citadel" or "castle". The building you see dates from 1723.

Escaliers du Roy

Exit the citadel, go along the church via rue Pierre Bistaudeau and continue to the "Escalier du Roy".

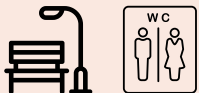
This staircase, known as the "Roy" staircase, owes its fame to a famous legend from 1650 featuring the young King Louis XIV, then aged 12, a fruit tree and a monk.

While he was taking a moment of recreation in Bourg, his attention was drawn to a beautiful fig tree with very tempting fruits. Alas, the branches were too high and the king could not catch the fruits. A monk passing by tried to help him by lifting him in his arms. Bad move! The guards on the lookout grabbed him and threw him in prison, accusing him of the crime of "lèse-majesté" for having dared to lay a hand on the king. Fortunately, the Queen Mother was amused by this story told by her son. She ordered the release of the monk whose only crime was to have wanted to be of service.

Option 1 : Go to point 8.

Quai des chantiers :

Did you know ?

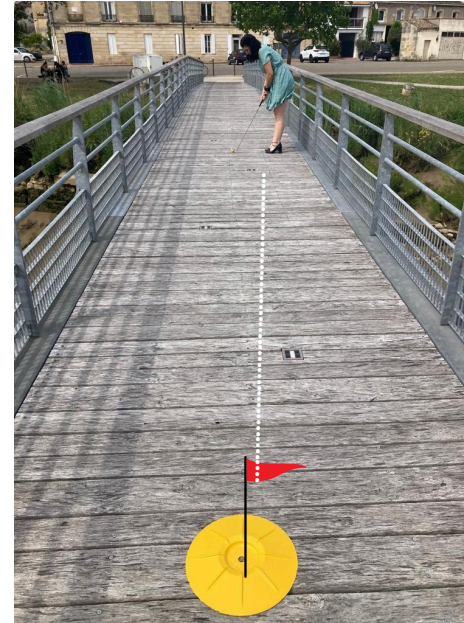
This washhouse was built in 1828. It has a washing basin (the largest) and a rinsing basin. The railings allowed these "washerwomen" to drain the laundry.

The water that supplies it comes from the fountain located under the Moorish villa and whose source has been flowing for more than 2000 years according to the Bourquais, inhabitants of Bourg.

Port

Head towards the port, along the Dordogne. At the quai Jean Bart there is a pontoon with free access.
Set up as below and play !



In the 15th century, the port was a central place in the village. Indeed, trade was one of the main activities. Three major resources were exchanged at that time: stone, wine and ? (circle the correct answer) :

Did you know ?

The port of Bourg was very busy until the Second World War. It showed the path of the gabares, the famous flat-bottomed boats that went up the Dordogne carrying local products to Bordeaux. The stone from Bourg was used to build the great monuments of Bordeaux such as the Grand Théâtre and the Place des Quinconces.
