

Route

- 1 Leave the Tourist office passing in front of the Wine house and the gate of the church, and turn left riding along the city wall.
- 2 Pass in front of the iron gate of Château Canon Follow this narrow road lined with low walls that winds through the vineyard.
- 3 At the stop, turn left towards Libourne.
- 4 At the bottom of the slope, turn right and take immediately the road on your left.
- 5 After the railway, beware of the traffic, you reach road D670 and cross it towards St Sulpice.
- 6 Pass Château Monbousquet and at the junction, at the entrance of St Sulpice, take slightly on your left the street «rue de Bertinat».
- 7 At the stop, continue straight on in the street «rue de la Dordogne», along the garage.
- 8 At the hamlet Pas de l'Âne, the road takes a right angle bend.
- 9 Continue following this road that turns left towards La Moulinat (sign Vignobles Xans).
- 10 At the junction, turn right towards Grand Barrail, Vignobles Xans.
- 11 Reach the bank of Dordogne river and turn left. Ride along the river up to Branne.
- 12 Pass under the bridge, the road turn left. Continue up to the crossroads.
- 13 Beware of the traffic, take road D936 on your left at the «give way» sign and cross the bridge.
- 14 After the bridge, turn left towards the Tourist office of Branne and Cabara.
- 15 Leave Branne riding along Dordogne river towards Cabara and keep right (busy road).
- 16 Watch out for cars and cross the road on your left towards Cabara.
- 17 Cross Cabara and leave Cabara straight on.
- 18 At the stop, take road D18 on your left towards St-Jean-de-Blaignac.

- 19 Pass Chaulne factory on your left and continue straight on towards Saint-Jean.
- 20 At the stop in St-Jean-de-Blaignac, turn left towards lavagnac.
- 21 Pass in front of the restaurant Auberge St-Jean and cross the bridge.
- 22 Cross Lavagnac and take the road of Sainte-Terre on your right. Ride along Dordogne river.
- 23 At the entrance of Sainte-Terre, turn right towards the center of the village.
- 24 In the center, pass near the church and at the junction, take slightly on your right the «rue du Parlement» (sign Circuit des condamines).
- 25 Ride along the river and cross the hamlet.
- 26 After the hamlet, the road turns left.
- 27 At the junction, turn left and follow the road.
- 28 Cross road D 123 and go straight on for 2 km.
- 29 Watch for cars and cross road D 936. Continue straight on for 500 meters.
- 30 At the junction turn right, and after the hamlet Gros turn right again towards St Etienne.
- 31 At the junction, take the road on your left. Then cross the railway.
- 32 At the crossroads, go straight on towards Château de Pressac et Château Mangot.
- 33 Turn left towards Château de Pressac. Hang in there, go up the long and steep slope !
- 34 Leave Château de Pressac, and at the crossroads, go straight and down.
- 35 At the junction, turn left and take immediately the first road on your right before the hamlet.
- 36 At the crossroads, turn right, take the next road on your left and cross Barbanne stream.



Tour of the Greater Saint-Emilion



Description

This loop of **46 kilomètres** is intended for riders who want to discover the vineyards and the heritage of Saint-Emilion during **1 or 2 days**. The 1st part, at the south near Sainte-Terre, is easy and offers beautiful views over Dordogne river. After Saint-Pey-d'Armens, you can reach Saint-Emilion via Saint-Hippolyte and Saint-Laurent-des-Combes (loop of 30 kms). The 2nd part, at the north near Montagne, is hilly (long slope of Château de Pressac). It offers panoramas over the vineyards and monuments to discover.

37 At the top of the hill, turn right and continue straight on for 1,5 kilometer.

38 Ride along Château des Laurets, turn left and pass in front of the entrance of the château.

39 At the crossroads, take road D 130 on your left and turn immediately right.

40 Cross the hamlet Le Chai and continue going down this narrow road.

41 At the bottom of the slope, turn left.

42 At the junction, turn right, pass Château Coucy, and cross the hamlet Bonneau.

43 Cross the hamlet Arvouet and continue straight on during 1 kilometer.

44 Go up, up to road D 244. And turn left towards Montagne.

45 In Montagne, continue straight on (pass in front of the church) or visit the village.

46 Pass the Wine house (on your right), go down and dismount your bike to take straight on the one-way street.

47 In front of Saint-Georges church, turn left.

48 At the gate of Château Saint-Georges, turn left or dismount your bike to visit the château.

49 Go down straight on, up to the bottom of the slope.

50 Cross Barbanne stream. At the pumping station, turn right towards Château Champion.

51 After Château Champion, go to the next crossroads and turn left.

52 Reach road D243 (watch for cars) and ride uphill on your right.

53 At the top of the hill, continue straight on or turn right to admire Château Soutard.

54 At the roundabout in St-Emilion, go straight on to reach the Tourist office.
